CITY OF CARLISLE

The City of Carlisle (General Traffic Control) Order 1972

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, for loading and unloading goods and for the maintenance of essential services but the exception for loading and unloading goods will not apply to parts of the roads specified in Part III of Schedule 2 where existing Orders prohibit such operations being undertaken between 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m., 12 noon and 1.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday.

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which together with a map showing the restricted area and the parking places, and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be seen at the Town Clerk's Office, Civic Centre, Carlisle during normal office hours.
