The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under Sections 3 (6) and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958:

The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 1) Order 1972.

This Order provides that the goods listed in the Schedule shall be temporarily exempt from import duty until 1st January 1973 or, in the case of certain items, until such earlier day as is specified.

The Order comes into operation on 3rd February 1972 and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1972 No. 52.
