The QUEEN has been pleased to issue a Warrant under Her Majesty's Royal Sign Manual in form following:

ELIZABETH THE SECOND by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Our other Realms and Territories QUEEN HEAD of the Commonwealth Defender of the Faith To Our right trusty and right entirely beloved Cousin and Counsellor Bernard Marmaduke Duke of Norfolk Knight of Our Most Noble Order of the Garter Knight Grand Cross of Our Royal Victorian Order Knight Grand Cross of Our Most Excellent Order of the British Empire upon whom has been conferred the Territorial Decoration Earl Marshal and Our Hereditary Marshal of England Greeting

WHEREAS We deem it expedient that the style title rank and precedence of Our Circuit Judges in England and Wales and the style and title of such Judges upon retirement should be established and defined

KNOW YE THEREFORE that in the exercise of Our Royal Prerogative We do hereby declare OUR ROYAL WILL AND PLEASURE that at all times hereafter Our Circuit Judges in England and Wales shall be called known and addressed by the style and title of "His Honour" prefixed to the word "Judge" before their respective names and shall have rank and precedence next after Knights Bachelor and shall as between themselves have rank and precedence in manner following

the Vice-Chancellor of the County Palatine of Lancaster

Our Circuit Judges who immediately before the 1st day of January 1972 held office as Official

Referees to the Supreme Court according to the priority of their respective appointments to such office

the Recorder of London

the Recorder of the City of Liverpool and the Recorder of the City of Manchester according to the priority of their respective appointments the Common Serjeant

Our Circuit Judges who immediately before the 1st day of January 1972 held one of the following judicial offices

Additional Judge of the Central Criminal Court
Assistant Judge of the Mayor's and City of London Court

County Court Judge

Whole time Chairman or whole time Deputy Chairman of courts of quarter sessions for Greater London Cheshire Durham Kent and Lancashire.

according to the priority or order of their respective appointments to such offices

Our other Circuit Judges according to the priority or order of their respective appointments

AND THAT OUR Circuit Judges upon retirement may retain the style and title of "His Honour" before their respective names

OUR ROYAL WILL AND PLEASURE further is that you Bernard Marmaduke Duke of Norfolk to whom the cognizance of matters of this nature doth properly belong do see this Our Order observed and kept and that you do cause the same to be recorded in Our College of Arms to the end that Our Officers of Arms and all others upon occasion may take full notice and have knowledge thereof
