WAGES COUNCILS ACT, 1959

Licensed Non-Residential Establishment Wages Council

The Licensed Non-residential Establishment Wages Council hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Secretary of State for Employment proposals for (1) varying the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Licensed Non-residential Establishment) Order, 1971 (Order L.N.R. (87)) and varying the provisions relating to statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Licensed Non-residential Establishment) Order, 1971 (Order L.N.R. (88)); (2) amending the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Licensed Non-residential Establishment) Order, 1971 (Order L.N.R. (87)) and varying the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages Regulations (Licensed Non-residential Establishment) (Managers and Club Stewards) Order, 1971 (Order L.N.R. (88)) and (3) the revocation of Orders L.N.R. (87) and L.N.R. (88).

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1971

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1971

Land Powers (Defence) Act, 1958

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971, as extended by section 8 of the Land Powers (Defence) Act, 1958, to authorise the stopping up of footpath No. 126A at Hangmoor Ranges, Pirbright, in the county of Surrey, to enable land to be used efficiently for defence installation without danger to the public.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping up of a length of Water Street, Mason Street, Old Hall Street, Corporation Street, Fountain Street, Suffield Street, Taylor Street, Albert Street, Victoria Street, and a part of Market Place, Middleton, Lancashire, in the interests of the safety of users of and to facilitate the movement of traffic on the A.669 Oldham Road/Corporation Street, Market Place Link Road, which are highways to be constructed and improved in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

The proposed Order will require the provision of new highways maintainable at the public expense, for which the highway authority is to be the Middleton Borough Council and the improvement of existing highways.
