PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

Stockton Rural District Council (Elwick Hall Foot-path No. 1) Public Path Extinguishment Order 1972.

Notice is hereby given that on 29th March 1972, the Stockton Rural District Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to extinguish the public right of way running from the point 617 yards north of the junction of Road C.25 with Trunk Road A.19 and marked "A" on the deposited plan in an easterly direction to the point in North Lane in the Parish of Elwick Hall marked "B" on the said plan and shown there by a line coloured brown.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the Council Offices, Cromer Lodge, Yarm Lane, Stockton on Tees and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m., Monday to Friday.

This Order becomes operative as from 29th March 1972, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1968, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he may, under section 178 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, within six weeks from 25th April 1972, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
