of Permitted Development (East Kirkby No. 1)
Direction, 1971.*

Notice is hereby given that the above-mentioned Direction has been made by the County Council of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963 and has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

The Direction relates to the land specified in the First Schedule hereto.
