HIGHWAYS ACT 1959

The Newtown—Aberystwyth Trunk Road (Llandiloes Road, Newtown Side Roads) Order 1972

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Llandiloes Road, Newtown in the County of Montgomery, he has made an Order under section 9 of the above Act which will authorise the Secretary of State:

- (a) to stop up lengths of highways, and
- (b) to construct a new highway to connect the superseded Trunk Road with the new trunk road to be constructed by the Secretary of State in pursuance of the Newtown—Aberystwyth Trunk Road (Llandiloes Road, Newtown) Order 1971, all at Newtown aforesaid, and providing for the transfer of the said highway to the County Council of Montgomery as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plan have been deposited at the Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours. Copies have also been deposited at the offices of Montgomeryshire C.C., County Offices, Welshpool where they are similarly open to inspection.

Copies of the Order, the title of which is "The Newtown—Aberystwyth Trunk Road (Llandiloes Road, Newtown Side Roads) Order 1972" can be obtained from the Welsh Office, Roads Division, Graham Buildings, Newport Road, Cardiff, CF2 1YU.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 8th June 1972, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
