

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County Borough of Grimsby) (No. 2) Order 1972", authorising the stopping up of lengths of Maude Street, Flottergate and part of Victoria Street, Grimsby, Lincs.

CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE
CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1952

To: AUTAR KAUR VIRDEE

15th June 1972.

Pursuant to section 275 (5) of the Customs and Excise Act 1952, and paragraph 1 of the 7th Schedule thereto, the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give you notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the customs and excise Acts and enactments amending those Acts, certain goods, being jewellery namely one gold and ruby-set necklace and pair of eardrops, two heavy bracelets, two gold rings, a gold watch strap and fifteen gold bangles, found in a safe deposit at the Swiss Bank, Coventry Street, London W.1, on the 21st January 1972 have been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds that:

- (1) the said Autar Kaur Virdee was a person entering the United Kingdom in July 1970 and the said goods were not declared by her as required by section 6 (1) of the Finance Act 1968; or
- (2) the said goods being imported goods chargeable with a duty were without payment of that duty removed by the said Autar Kaur Virdee from their place of importation.

Whereby and by force of section (1) 6 (1) of the Finance Act 1968; (2) 44 (a) of the Customs and Excise Act 1952 the said goods are liable to forfeiture.
