NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE CUSTOMS & EXCISE ACT 1952

To: SURINDER SINGH VIRDEE

15th June 1972.

Pursuant to section 275 (5) of the Customs and Excise Act 1952, and paragraph 1 of the 7th Schedule thereto, the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give you notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the customs and excise Acts and enactments amending those Acts, certain goods, being jewellery namely one gold bangle and one signet ring, found in a deposit safe at the Swiss Bank, New Coventry

Street, London W.1, on the 21st January 1972 have been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds that:
