Rural District of Warwick, Diversion of Footpath W.129 (Weston-under-Wetherley) Order, 1972

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order made on 19th July 1972 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the Warwick Rural District Council.
