The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 1 of the Burial Act 1853 (1853 c. 134) and of all other powers Her enabling, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

2. Burials shall be discontinued forthwith and entirely in the Churchyard of St. Mary the Virgin, Upchurch, in the County of Kent, which is shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto.
3. This Order may be cited as the Burial Grounds (Churchyard of St. Mary the Virgin, Upchurch, Kent) Order 1972.
