TELECOMMUNICATIONS CHARGES NOTICE E33/1972

1. TELEPHONE CALLS (EXCEPT DATEL CALLS AND CALLS FROM CALL OFFICES AND COIN BOX LINES OBTAINED WITHOUT THE ASSISTANCE OF AN OPERATOR) FROM PLACES WITHIN THE UNITED KINGDOM AND THE ISLE OF MAN TO THE PHILIPPINES: 2. TRANSFERRED CHARGE TELEPHONE CALLS FROM THE PHILIPPINES TO PLACES WITHIN THE UNITED KINGDOM AND THE ISLE OF MAN: 3. CREDIT CARD TELEPHONE CALLS FROM THE PHILIPPINES TO PLACES WITHIN THE UNITED KINGDOM AND THE ISLE OF MAN.

1. The Post Office hereby gives notice that as from 21st August 1972 the charges for telephone calls (except Datal calls and calls from call offices and coin box lines obtained without the assistance of an operator) from places within the United Kingdom and the Isle of Man to the Philippines are as shown in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Notice; the charges for the personal call facility in relation to such calls are as shown in column 4 of the said Schedule. These charges have been fixed by the Post Office in accordance with paragraph 23(1) and 28(3) of the Post Office Telephone Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme T1/1971) and may be revised by the Post Office without notice.

2. The Post Office hereby further gives notice that as from 21st August 1972 the charges for transferred charge calls made from the Philippines when the person answering a called telephone in the United Kingdom or the Isle of Man consents to the call charges being reversed are as shown in columns 5 and 6 of the Schedule to this Notice. These charges have been fixed by the Post Office in accordance with paragraph 34(3)(a) of the Post Office Telephone Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme T1/1971) and may be revised by the Post Office without notice.

3. The Post Office hereby further gives notice that as from 21st August 1972 the charges for credit card calls made from telephones on the telephone systems of Authorities providing service in the Philippines to any telephone in the United Kingdom and the Isle of Man are as shown in columns 7, 8 and 9 of the Schedule to this Notice. These charges have been fixed by the Post Office in accordance with paragraph 35(6)(b) of the Post Office Telephone Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme T1/1971) and may be revised by the Post Office without notice.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BARROW-IN-FURNESS COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Barrow-in-Furness (Various Roads) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1972

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Barrow-in-Furness propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

When this Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time Mondays to Saturdays on the greater part of each of the following roads:

- (1) Lawson Street between Cornwallis Street and Abbey Road (both sides);
- (2) Cornwallis Street between Hindpool Road and Lawson Street (both sides): between Lawson Street and Duke Street (a) the south side and (b) co-extensive with the Imperial Garage and at the Duke Street junction on the North side;
- (3) Sidney Street (a) on the north side (b) on the south side between Clifford Street and Duke Street and at the junction with Lawson Street;
- (4) Duncan Street (north side);
- (5) St. Vincent Street (a) between Hindpool Road and Lawson Street (b) between Duke Street and

- Clifford Street (c) at the junctions with Clifford Street and Lawson Street;
- (6) Keith Street (south side);
- (7) Parade Street (a) south side (b) between Clifford Street and Duke Street;
- (8) Clifford Street (a) on the length which runs easterly behind the Fire Station, on the north side only (b) on the remainder as far as Sidney Street, on both sides;
- (9) Abbey Road (a) (south side) between Ramsden Square and Hindpool Road (b) (north side) for 40 metres from Hindpool Road and for 40 metres from Ramsden Square;
- (10) Laundry Street (both sides);
- (11) Chapel Street (both sides);
- (12) Greengate Street (south side) between back Rawlinson Street and School Street.

Waiting will be limited to one hour in any period of two hours in those parts of the following streets which are not subject to the prohibition of waiting detailed in paragraph 2 above, i.e.

- (1) Cornwallis Street (north side);
- (2) Sidney Street (south side);
- (3) Duncan Street (south side);
- (4) St. Vincent Street (both sides) between Lawson Street and Clifford Street;
- (5) Keith Street (north side);
- (6) Parade Street (north side);
- (7) Clifford Street (south side) opposite the Fire Station and Welfare Clinic;
