The Winchester—Preston Trunk Road (Whitchurch—Litchfield By-Pass and Slip Roads) Order 1972

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 7 of the Highways Act 1959, the effect of which is to provide that roads which he proposes to construct at Whitchurch and Litchfield in the county of Hampshire shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation and that the length of the Winchester—Preston Trunk Road to be superseded shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which notice is given by him to the County Council of Hampshire that the new trunk roads are open for through traffic.

The Winchester—Preston Trunk Road (Whitchurch—Litchfield By-Pass Side Roads) Order 1972
