Notice is hereby given that the County Council have made an Order under section 72 (3) and section 73 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to impose a $30 \mathrm{~m} . \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{h}$. speed limit in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice with effect from the 5th September 1972.
