PRESENT,

The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 1 of the Naval and Marine Reserves Pay Act 1957 (1957 c. 32) and section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865 (1865 c. 73) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

#### Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Naval Reserves (Gibraltar) Pay (Amendment) Order 1972.

#### Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889 (1889 c. 63) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

#### Rates of Pay for Men for Continuous Training

3. The rates of pay for continuous training payable from 1st March 1972 to men recruited locally for service with the Headquarters Reserve Unit of the Royal Naval Reserve at Gibraltar shall be as set out in the Schedule to this Order and shall be substituted for the rates set out in the Schedule to the Naval Reserves (Gibraltar) Pay Order 1971.
