The County of Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely (Various Streets and South of the River Nene Wisbech) (Prohibi-tion and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1973.

Notice is hereby given that on the 2nd January 1973 the Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to:

(a) Prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in any of the lengths or on any of the sides of road specified in the First Schedule to this notice.

(b) Prohibit the waiting of vehicles on any day other than a Sunday between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. on either sides of road specified in the Second Schedule to this notice

(c) Prohibit the waiting of vehicles for longer than 30 minutes in any one hour on any day other than a Sunday between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. on of the sides of road specified in the Third Schedule to this notice.

(d) Revoke those parts of The County of Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely (Various Streets South of the River Nene, Wisbech) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1968 which relate to Norwich Road, Wisbech.

A copy of the Order together with a map showing the roads to which the proposed Order relates and the Order, parts of which are to be revoked, may be inspected during normal office hours at the office of the Associate County Surveyor, County Hall, March, Cambs, and at the office of the Town Clerk, Wisbech Borough Council, Town Hall, Wisbech.

Exceptions are contained in the Order to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from a vehicle; to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with the delivery or collection of to be used in connection with the delivery or collection of postal packets, building operations, demolition, the maintenance of the roads and public utility services, to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage and to permit a vehicle to wait beyond the maximum waiting period specified on either of the sides of road described in the Third Schedule to this notice if the vehicle is a disabled persons vehicle within the meaning of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1971 which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge issued in the relevant position a disabled persons badge issued by any local authority.

The Order will come into operation on the 15th January

1973.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 12th January 1973 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
