

## SCHEDULE

(The distances are approximate)

The highways to be stopped up are at Cardiff in the County of Glamorgan. They are shown edged black on the deposited plan and are:

1. That length of Hewell Street which extends from a point 23 yards south-east of its junction with Bromsgrove Street in south-easterly direction for a distance of 48 yards.
2. That length of Oakley Street which extends from its junction with Bromsgrove Street in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 69 yards.

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971, to authorise the stopping up of those lengths of highway described in the Schedule below to enable redevelopment to be carried out in accordance with a planning application made to Cardiff County Borough Council under Part III of that Act.

During 28 days from the 16th January 1973 copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Cardiff County Borough Council, City Hall, Cardiff, and may be obtained free of charge from the Secretary of State (quoting reference R15/234/26) at the address stated below.

## SCHEDULE

(The distances are approximate)

The highways to be stopped up are at Cardiff in the County of Glamorgan. They are shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan and are:

1. That length of Worcester Street which extends from its junction with Clive Street in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Knole Street, a distance of 147 yards.
2. That length of Knole Street which extends from its junction with Bromsgrove Street in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 113 yards.
3. That side of Knole Street which extends from its junction with the northern side of Worcester Street to its junction with Holmesdale Street, a distance of 27 yards.
4. That length of Oakley Street which extends from a point 69 yards south-east of its junction with Bromsgrove Street in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Holmesdale Street, a distance of 143 yards.
5. That length of Hewell Street which extends from a point 71 yards south-east of its junction with Bromsgrove Street in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Holmesdale Street, a distance of 192 yards.
