ALDRIDGE-BROWNHILLS URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967

Aldridge-Brownhills Urban District Council Queslett Road Service Road, Pheasey, One-Way Traffic Order 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Aldridge-Brownhills Urban District Council in exercise of their powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, have made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle on the length of road specified in the first column of the Schedule to this notice otherwise than in the direction specified in the second column of the said Schedule.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the length of road in question may be inspected at the Council House, Rookery Lane, Aldridge, during normal office hours.

The Order will come into operation on the 16th April 1973.

Any person who desires to question the validity of any provision contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of section 1 of the Road Traffic Act, 1967, or on the grounds that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act, or any regulation made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks from the date of this notice make application for the purpose to the High Court.
