The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under Section 16(2) of the Post Office Act 1953 as amended by section 76 of, and paragraph 2 (4) of Schedule 4 to, the Post Office Act 1969 and by section 17 (4) of the Finance Act 1972 viz: The Postal Packets (Customs and Excise) Amendment (No. 1) Regulations 1973. These Regulations, which come into operation on 1st April 1973, amend the Postal Packets (Customs and Excise) Regulations 1971, which set out the customs requirements relating to incoming and outgoing postal packets and to goods contained in them. Changes in the 1971 Regulations are necessitated by the provisions of the Finance Act 1972 which provides that purchase tax shall not be charged on goods imported into the United Kingdom after 31st March 1973 and that value added tax shall be charged on goods imported into the United Kingdom on or after 1st April 1973.

The Order comes into operation on 1st April 1973, and has been published as Statutory Instrument 1973 No. 411.
