GENERAL PIER AND HARBOUR ACT 1861 AND THE GENERAL PIER AND HARBOUR ACT 1861 AMENDMENT ACT.

The Proposed Fishguard and Goodwick Harbour Provisional Order

Notice is hereby given that a Public Local Inquiry into objections made with respect to the above proposed Order will be held by Mr. F. A. Adams, C.B. (a person appointed

by the Secretary of State for that purpose) at the Court Room, Town Hall, Fishguard, on Thursday, 26th April 1973, at 10.30. Representations from persons who have objected to the proposed Order and from any other persons who desire to appear will be heard.

The proposed Order, which has been applied for by the Fishguard and Goodwick Urban District Council would confer the following powers upon the Council:

- (i) To incorporate the provisions of the Harbours, Docks and Piers Clauses Act 1847 (except sections 1, 6 to 13, 16 to 23, 25 to 27, 29 to 31, 42, 50, 84 to 90, 97 and 98);
- (ii) To enable the Council, in addition to the power to charge ship, passenger and goods dues conferred on a harbour authority by virtue of section 26 (2) of the Harbours Act 1964, to levy dues in respect of any floating manufactured article and in respect of port facilities and services.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 211 of the above Act entitled "The Urban District Council of Houghton-le-Spring (A.183 Chester Road, Peshaw) Road Scheme Order 1973" authorising the stopping up of parts of Chester Road, Peshaw (A.183) and requiring the provision of a new highway.
