### TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

1. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Cashier's Office at the Bank of England on Friday, the 13th April 1973, at 1 p.m., for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bill Act, 1877, and the National Loans Act, 1968, to the amount of £60,000,000. 2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000,  $\pounds 25,000, \pounds 50,000 \pounds 100,000$  or £250,000. They will be dated at the option of the tenderer on any business day from Monday, the 16th April 1973, to Thursday, the 19th April 1973 inclusive, and will be due 91 days after date. 3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of Exclused

England. 4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000, and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated, and the net amount per cent. (being a multiple of one new half-penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.
