ST. AUSTELL WITH FOWEY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of St. Austell with Fowey (Bugle) (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1973.

Notice is hereby given that the St. Austell with Fowey Borough Council have on the 24th April 1973, made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968. This Order will come into operation on the 1st May 1973.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting at any time in each of the following roads for a distance of 25 yards from its junction with the other roads:

- (1) Fore Street.
- (2) Roche Road.
- (3) Rosevear Road.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods, and, where necessary in connection with
- (c) the maintenance of the roads;
- (d) building operations;
- (e) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84 (A), 84 (B) or 84 (C) of the Act or any Regulations made under the said section 84 (C) has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks of the date on which the Order is made such date being stated in the notice make application for the purpose of the High Court.

SHREWSBURY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Shrewsbury (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order No. 1 1973.

Notice is hereby given that the Shrewsbury Borough Council have made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting at any time in that length of the south-western side of Howard Street between a point 35 yards south-east of its junction with Castle Foregate and a point 57 yards south-east of that junction. This restriction is in addition to existing restrictions prohibiting waiting at any time on the north-eastern side of Howard Street and between the junction with Castle Foregate and a point 35 yards south-east of that junction on the south-western side of Howard Street.

Exceptions have been provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle or to

enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

The Order will come into force on 30th April 1973.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967

The London Borough of Southwark (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Southwark intend to make the London Borough of Southwark (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order, 1973 relating to an off-street car park provided by the Council on the east side of Sumner Road near its junction with Peckham High Street.

The proposed Order will amend the London Borough of Southwark (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1972 so as to apply its provisions to the Sumner Road car park. This Order prescribes the types and classes of vehicle which may wait in the parking place and the days and hours during which the parking place will be available, the manner of waiting and payment of charges, the charges levied in such parking place, the maximum period of waiting, the Council's powers of removal of vehicles parked in the parking place in contravention of the provisions in the Order, and incidental matters.

The Order provides that the following charges shall be paid in respect of the parking of vehicles of the prescribed class in the parking place for any period between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any weekday other than a Bank Holiday:

Monday to Friday inclusive:

2 hours	5p
Exceeding 2 hours	10p

Saturday:

1 hour	5p
4 hours	10p (maximum)

Season ticket:

One month	£1
Three months	£3
Six months	£6
