The Order is experimental and will remain in force for an initial period of six months. It is intended to overcome the congestion which occurs in Wellington Road when sporting activities are taking place in Oaklands Park. Exemptions have been included in the Order to permit (among other things) (a) the picking up and setting down of passengers, and (b) the loading and unloading of goods.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of road affected are available for inspection at the office of the undersigned during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 24th April 1973, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
