NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1971
SECTION 210

*The County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire
(Footpath No. 15, Capeltown, Wortley Rural District)
Public Path Diversion Order 1973*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on 26th April 1973 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the length of footpath which runs from a point adjacent to the northern boundary of No. 392 Burncross Road, Chapeltown, in the parish of Ecclesfield, in an approximate north/north-westerly direction along the boundary between O.S. Field Nos. 1532 and 3736 for a distance of 205 metres or thereabouts.

The diverted footpath will run from the same starting point in a north/north-westerly direction between Nos. 33 and 35 Bowland Drive for 32 metres or thereabouts, thence across Bowland Drive for 8 metres or thereabouts, thence along the footway on the western side of Bowland Drive for 50 metres or thereabouts, across Wharfedale Drive for 12 metres or thereabouts, thence in a north/north-westerly direction along a footpath constructed to the rear of 1-19 Derwent Drive for 110 metres or thereabouts, until it rejoins the original footpath at the most northerly point of the length to be diverted.

Copies of the Order and the map contained in it have been deposited at the Wortley Rural District Council Offices, Grenoside, near Sheffield, and at the County Hall, Wakefield, and may be inspected free of charge between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Friday.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the Clerk of the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire, County Hall,

Wakefield, not later than 26th May 1973 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made or if any so made are withdrawn, the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted for confirmation any representations and objections which have been made and not withdrawn will be sent to the Secretary of State with the Order.
