MIDDLETON BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Middleton (Prohibition of Waiting) (Goods Vehicles) Traffic Regulation Order, 1973*

Notice is hereby given that the Middleton Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, affecting the whole of the Langley Housing Estate and certain other streets.

The effect of this Order is to make permanent the two Experimental Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the same streets.

When the Order comes into operation no one will be permitted to leave a goods vehicle, the unladen weight of which exceeds 30 cwt., at any time in any road on the Langley Housing Estate and certain other streets.

- (d) the maintenance of the roads;

- (f) taking in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage.

Full details are contained in the draft Order, which, together with a map showing the restricted areas and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the Town Hall, Middleton, during normal office hours.
