The Borough of Nuneaton (Seymour Road) Prohibition of Waiting Order 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Nuneaton Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the road to which the Order relates, together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the offices of the undersigned during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 30th May 1973.

The County Borough of Oldham (Various Streets) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Oldham County Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of any vehicle along the roads and lengths of road indicated in Column 1 of the Schedule to the Order, in a direction other than that indicated in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
