Notice is hereby given that the Staines Urban District Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part I of the Transport Act 1968.

The effect of this Order will be to continue the prohibition of waiting at any time and the one-way system already in operation by virtue of the Urban District of Staines (Tothill Street, Staines) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) and (Traffic Regulation) Order 1972, made on 1st December 1972, and continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State.
