(d) Running from the said point on the railway line opposite Carthouse Lane described in (b) above in a north-easterly direction for 150 yards and thence in a general westerly direction for 200 yards to the bank of the River Teme.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Martley Rural District Council Offices, Bedwardine House, Rushwick, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. from 24th May 1973.

The Order became operative as from 16th November 1972, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question

the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act as amended, or of any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 to the Act, within six weeks from the 24th May 1973, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
