Fishery Byelaw

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

LEIGH BOROUGH COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

Borough of Leigh Smoke Control Order (No. 15) 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Leigh Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 6th June 1973 made an Order entitled the Borough of Leigh Smoke Control Order (No. 15) 1973, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (2) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of any offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.
