TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Nottingham) (No. 1) Order 1973" authorising the stopping up of a length of Union Street and lengths of Meeting House Lane, Mansfield, and requiring the provision of new highways.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Regional Controller (Roads and Transportation), Cranbrook House, Cranbrook Street, Nottingham, NG1 1EX (quoting DEM 70035/1/017) and may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Mansfield Borough Council, Carr Bank, Mansfield.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 26th July 1973, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that on the application of the Huddersfield County Borough Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of New Street, Huddersfield.
