At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 27th day of July 1973

PRESENT,

THE QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865(a) it is enacted that all pay, wages, pensions, bounty money, grants or other allowances in the nature thereof, payable in respect of services in Her Majesty's naval or marine force to a person being or having been an officer, seaman or marine, or to the widow or any relative of a deceased officer, seaman or marine, shall be paid in such manner and subject to such restrictions, conditions and provisions, as are from time to time directed by Order in Council:

And whereas Her Majesty deems it expedient to amend the Order in Council dated 25th September 1964, as amended (b), concerning pensions and other grants in respect of disablement or death due to service in the naval forces during the 1914 World War and after 2nd September 1939 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1964 Order"):

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her as aforesaid and of all other powers whatsoever Her thereunto enabling, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered that, notwithstanding anything in the 1964 Order, the following provisions of this Order shall take effect accordingly and, except in the cases stated in the Order in Council of 19th December 1881, and except as otherwise provided by statute, shall be established and obeyed as the sole authority in the matters herein treated of.

Substitution of Schedules to the 1964 Order

1. For Schedules 2, 3, 4, 6 and 7 to the 1964 Order (rates of pensions and other grants payable in respect of disablement or death due to service in the naval forces during the 1914 World War and after 2nd September 1939) there shall be substituted the Schedules set out in Part I of the Appendix hereto and numbered 2, 3, 4, 6 and 7 respectively.

Amendment of Articles of the 1964 Order

2.—(1) In Articles 15 (severe disablement occupational allowance), 17 (unemployability allowances), 19 (allowance for lowered standard of occupation), 21 (treatment allowances) and 25 (application of Part IV) of the 1964 Order there shall be made the amendments set out in Part II of the Appendix hereto.

(2) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Article, sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (4) of the said Article 17 shall continue to apply to an award made thereunder before 1st October 1973 as it would have applied had this Order not issued in all cases where the rate of allowance payable under such award was not, having regard to the financial circumstances of the person in respect of whom the allowance had been granted, further increased under sub-paragraph (c) of the said paragraph (4):
