For their exceptional courage and devotion to duty, as For their exceptional courage and devotion to duty, as Hercules Captains in the joint force which successfully carried out the famine relief supply dropping operation in Nepal, from the end of February to the beginning of April 1973. They were the three pilots responsible for perfecting the demanding flying and dropping techniques used in the operation, during which 1,957 metric tons of grain were delivered from airheads in Southern Nepal onto landing strips and dropping zones in the remote Himalayan hinterland, where the deep valleys leave no room for error and where terrain, climate and altitude allow infinitely smaller margins of safety than usual. Flight Lieutenant Mahon pioneered the free drop technique at Doti Silgarhi and was the only pilot to free drop on the 7,600 foot high, mountain the only pilot to free drop on the 7,600 foot high, mountain encircled Jumla airstrip. Flight Lieutenant Titterton carried out the first air landings at Surket where, as the smallest error could easily have led to the aircraft sinking into the ground he flew in with the steel plank to make a safe parking

area for other pilots. Flight Lieutenant Williams dropped 36 one ton parachute cluster packs in a narrow valley flanked by ridges of 15,000 and 20,000 feet.
