**HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967**

*The Hampshire (A.27 North Baddesley) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order, 1973*

Notice is hereby given that the Hampshire County Council propose subject to the consent of the Secretary of State for the Environment to make an Order under section 74 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for Hampshire the effect of which will be that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice shall become subject to a speed limit of 40 m.p.h. That length of the Bassett (Southampton) to Romsey Road (A.27) at North Baddesley in the Rural District of Romsey and Stockbridge which extends from a point 243 yards north-west of its junction with Firgrove Road to a point 100 yards north-west of the north-western junction with Rownham Lane, a total distance of approximately 817 yards.
