PROPOSED ORDER

The Borough of Heywood (Pine Street) (No Waiting) Order 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Heywood propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times on Pine Street, north side, from a point 6.1 metres east of Hind Hill Street for a distance of 72.5 metres in an easterly direction to a point 6.1 metres west of Wood Street.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order for waiting (a) by direction or permission of a police constable in uniform; (b) for persons to board or alight from vehicles; (c) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from vehicles; (d) to enable vehicles if in the service of or employed by the Post Office to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets; (e) by vehicles used for any building operation, or demolition, removal of any obstructions to traffic, maintenance of roads or of the services therein.
