ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

Imposition of 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 74 (1) and section 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, prohibiting the driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.

The Order imposing a speed limit of 40 m.p.h. at present in force on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice is hereby revoked.
