#### HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

*The West Moor Link Trunk Road Order, 1973*

*The West Moor Link Trunk Road (Side Roads) Order, 1973*

*The M18 Rotherham-Goole Motorway (Armthorpe to Hatfield Section Side Roads) Order, 1973*

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that after holding Public Local Inquiries he has made the following Orders:

1.1 An Order under sections 7 and 44 of the Highways Act 1959 and section 68 of the Highways Act 1971 providing that a road which he proposes to construct at West Moor, near Doncaster, in the County of York, West Riding, shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation.

1.2 An Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 and sections 3 and 62 of the Highways Act 1971 authorising him:

- (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (ii) to stop up highways,
- (iii) to construct new highways, and
- (iv) to provide new means of access to premises

all at or in the vicinity of the above-mentioned trunk road, and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of York, West Riding, as from the date on which he notifies that Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.

1.3 An Order under sections 13 and 18 of the Highways Act 1959, section 27 of the Local Government Act 1966 and section 62 of the Highways Act 1971 which will:

(a) authorise him:

- (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (ii) to stop up highways,
- (iii) to construct new highways,
- (iv) to stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (v) to provide new means of access to premises,

all in relation to that part of the motorway which is to be provided by the Secretary of State under the M18 Rotherham-Goole Motorway (Wadworth to Hatfield Section) and Connecting Roads Scheme 1972 which is in or in the vicinity of or between Armthorpe and Hatfield, and

(b) provide for the transfer of the said new highways (except the new highway which will be a trunk road) to the County Council of York, West Riding, as from the date on which he notifies that Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.

Area Office, Leicester Avenue, Doncaster and the Central Library, Waterdale, Doncaster; the Armthorpe Branch Library, Church Street, Armthorpe,

near Doncaster and Hatfield Sub-Post Office, Hatfield, near Doncaster.

Any person aggrieved by the Orders and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that they are not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959 or the Highways Act 1971 or on the ground that any requirement of either of those Acts, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may within 6 weeks from 18th December 1973, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Orders or of any provision contained therein.

#### HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

*The Liverpool-Skegness Trunk Road (Horncastle Internal Relief Road) Order, 1973*

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that after holding a Public Inquiry he has made an Order under section 7 of the Highways Act 1959, the effect of which is to provide that a road which he proposes to construct at Horncastle in the County of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation and that the length of the Liverpool-Skegness Trunk Road to be superseded shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which notice is given by him to the County Council of Lincoln Parts of Lindsey that the Horncastle Internal Relief Road is open for through traffic.
