SCHEDULE

Sides of the London—Holyhead trunk road (A.5) (herein after referred to as "the trunk road") at Bethesda, in the Urban District of Bethesda in the county of Caernarvon.

1. The north-eastern side of that length of trunk road, known in part as Penrhyn Terrace and in part as High Street, which extends from a point 135 yards north-west of its junction with Lon Pab in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 68 yards.

2. The south-western side of that length of the trunk road, known in part as Penrhyn Terrace and in part as High Street, which extends from a point 135 yards north-west of its junction with Lon Pab in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 165 yards.

The Trunk Road (New Road, Skewen; Neath Abbey Road, Neath; and Cadoxton Road, Neath) (Bus Stops) (Clearway) Order 1974.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State intends to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The purpose of the Order is to prohibit vehicles, other than buses, from waiting between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day at any bus stop in any of the roads specified below where the carriageway at that stop is marked (a) as a bus stop, and (b) with a broad yellow line adjacent to the edge of the carriageway ("the authorised markings"):

New Road, Skewen.
Neath Abbey Road, Neath.
Cadoxton Road, Neath.

Although the Order includes every bus stop in the roads specified above, it should be noted that the provisions of the Order which prohibit waiting will only apply to those bus stops which the Secretary of State marks with the authorised markings.

While the Order remains in force it enables the Secretary of State at any time to lay or remove the authorised markings at or from any bus stop in a specified road or to adjust the position in that road of the authorised markings, as traffic conditions may require.

Other vehicles will be permitted to wait at the bus stops with authorised markings where necessary for:

1. the removal of an obstruction to traffic,
2. The maintenance of the road and in exercise of statutory powers with permission of the local authority, and
3. reasons of emergency.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the Neath Borough Council Offices, Town Hall, Neath.
