The County Borough of Birkenhead (General Traffic Control) Order, 1968 (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that on the 15th January 1974 the Council of the County Borough of Birkenhead made an Order under sections 1, 28, 31 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will prohibit parking of vehicles at any time on those lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.
