BARNET LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

London Borough of Barnet Smoke Control (No. 16) Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 11th day of January 1974, made an Order entitled the London Borough of Barnet Smoke Control (No. 16) Order, 1973, declaring the area described in the Schedule below to be a smoke control area. The Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st October 1974 or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map to which it refers may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, The Burroughs, Hendon, London N.W.4, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 8th February 1974.

Within that period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

Area bounded by a line commencing at the Borough's northern boundary in the centre of Galley Lane and running in an easterly direction along the centre of Galley Lane and continuing in an easterly direction along the centre of Wood Street to a point in line with the rear boundaries of the gardens of the houses on the east side of Hillside Gardens; thence southwards along the rear boundaries of these gardens to the centre point of Mays Lane; thence eastwards along the centre of Mays Lane and Underhill to the centre point of Great North Road; thence south-easterly along the centre of Great North Road to a point in line with the centre of Station Road and easterly along the centre of Station Road and continuing in a south-easterly direction along the centre of East Barnet Road to a point in line with the centre of Margaret Road; thence proceeding eastwards along the centre of Margaret Road to the centre point of Park Road; thence northwards along the centre of Park Road to a point in line with the centre of Edgeworth Road, thence north-easterly along the centre of Edgeworth Road and the north-west section of the Mount Pleasant roundabout to a point in line with the rear boundaries of the gardens of the properties on the eastern side of Northfield Road; thence along the rear boundaries of the gardens of properties numbered 2 to 26 on the eastern side of Northfield Road and thence by a line directly north to the Borough boundary in Hadley Wood; thence proceeding generally westwards along the Borough's northern boundary to the point of commencement.

BURY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Bury (No. 10) Smoke Control Order 1974

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Bury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, on the 23rd January 1974, made an Order entitled: "The Bury (No. 10) Smoke Control Order 1974" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to certain exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st July 1975, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the plan referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Department, Town Hall, Bury, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 15th February 1974.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
