- (a) Revoke the Ashton-in-Makerfield (Street Parking Places) Order 1964, in so far as it relates to Garswood Street, the Order otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
- (b) Prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times on the undermentioned lengths of the street in the Urban District of Ashton-in-Makerfield.
  - (i) Both sides of Garswood Street from its junction with Bryn Street for a distance of 346 metres on the southerly side and 44.2 metres on the northerly side.
