HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

The Trunk Road (Colwyn Bay) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1974

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State has made an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to amend the Trunk Road (Colwyn Bay) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1961, as varied by the Trunk Road (Colwyn Bay) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1966, which, as amended, imposed prohibition and restrictions on vehicles with regard to waiting between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. in specified lengths of the Chester—Bangor Trunk Road (A.55) at Colwyn Bay.

The amendments are as follows:

- (1) Instead of vehicles being restricted in their waiting between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. in the length of Abergele Road from its junction with Rhiw Road to its junction with Nant-y-Glyn Road, vehicles will now be restricted in their waiting between 8 a.m. and midnight. The restriction is to be of the alternating unilateral type, and where waiting is not for the time being prohibited, waiting will be limited to 45 minutes in any 2 hours.
- (2) The alternating unilateral restrictions referred to above are also to be extended to apply to the length of Abergele Road from its junction with Nant-y-Glyn Road to a point 31 yards south-east of that junction.
- (3) The above restrictions will be partially relaxed in the case of invalid and disabled persons' vehicles.
- (4) The Order results in the Trunk Road (Colwyn Bay) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1966 being revoked.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks of the 25th March 1974 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

The M4 Motorway (Tredegar Park—St. Mellons Section) and Connecting Roads (Side Roads No. 2) Order 197

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes in relation to that part of the M4 Motorway which will be situated between Tredegar Park in the County of Gwent and St. Mellons in the County of South Glamorgan to make under section 13 of the Highways Act 1959 an Order which will:

- (a) authorise him—
 - (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
 - (ii) to stop up highways,
 - (iii) to construct new highways,
 - (iv) to stop up private means of access to premises, and
 - (v) to provide new means of access to premises, all on or in the vicinity of the route of the above-mentioned part of the said motorway, and

- (b) provide for the transfer of the said new highways to the County Council of Gwent as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Order and of the relevant plan may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 4th April 1974 to 16th May 1974 at the Welsh Office, Roads Division, Graham Buildings, Newport Road, Cardiff, and at the offices of Gwent County Council, County Hall, Newport, and Newport District Council, Civic Centre, Newport.

Any person may not later than 16th May 1974 object to the making of the Order, by notice to the Secretary of State, at the Welsh Office, Roads Division, Graham Buildings, Newport Road, Cardiff, CF2 1YU, quoting reference R11/230/25 and stating the grounds of objection.
