Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to regulate traffic at Newquay by :

(i) prohibiting the waiting of vehicles

(a) at any time during the period from the 1st October-30th April (both dates inclusive) in each year in any of the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto;

(b) at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto;

specified in the Second Schedule hereto; (c) at any time during the period from the 1st May -30th September (both dates inclusive) in each year in any of the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule hereto; (d) between the hours of 9 a.m.—9 p.m. daily during the period from the 1st May—30th September (both dates inclusive) in each year in any of the lengths of road specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto; hereto;

(ii) limiting the waiting of vehicles, except the vehicles of disabled persons, to 30 minutes in one hour between the hours of 9 a.m.—6 p.m. daily during the period from the 1st October—30th April (both dates inclusive) in each year in either of the lengths of road specified in the lifth Schedule herets. the Fifth Schedule hereto;

(iii) revoking the existing restrictions on waiting during the summer months in those lengths of road specified in the Sixth Schedule hereto; and
(iv) amending or revoking and consolidating existing traffic regulation Orders operating at Newquay as may

be necessary arising from the foregoing.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to allow a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to allow a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; to enable postal packets to be delivered or collected; in connection with statutory

to be delivered or collected; in connection with statutory powers or duties, building operations, the maintenance or improvement of the lengths of road or of the services there in; to take in petrol, oil, water or air from a garage and in connection with a funeral.
