ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Derbyshire County Council (Various Roads, Matlock Bath) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1974

Notice is hereby given that on 9th May 1974 the Derbyshire County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is:

That no person (except those requiring access to premises) shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the following lengths of road in Matlock Bath:

*Upperwood Road
Masson Road
Brunswood Road
Hope Terrace
Holme Road*

Waterloo Road (part). From its junction with Temple Walk to its junction with Holme Road.

The Order comes into effect on Monday, 20th May 1974. A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the restricted lengths of road may be examined at the County Offices, Matlock (Room 109) during normal office hours, i.e. 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Friday.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instruments made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 9th May 1974 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
