THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS ACT 1868

THE GOVERNING BODY OF CHARTERHOUSE SCHOOL having, on the 13th day of March 1974, in virtue of the powers conferred upon them by the above-named Act, made a Statute in the terms appended hereto amending the Statute for determining and establishing the Constitution of the Governing Body of the said School, the said Statute is hereby published in the London Gazette in accordance with the provisions in that behalf contained in the said Act.

And Notice is hereby given that any person, body of persons, or body corporate, authorised in that behalf by the said Act, may, within two months after the publication of this notification, petition Her Majesty in Council to withhold Her approval from the whole or any part of the said Statute.

STATUTE made by the Governing Body of Charterhouse School on the 13th day of March 1974.

WE, THE GOVERNING BODY OF CHARTERHOUSE SCHOOL in virtue of the powers invested in us by the Public Schools Act 1868, and of all other powers enabling us in that behalf, do hereby make the following Statute amending the Statute sealed by the Special Commissioners appointed for the purpose by the Public Schools Act 1868 on the 22nd day of April 1871:

A. That paragraphs numbered 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 shall be repealed or amended to the extent and in the manner following:

Paragraphs numbered 1 and 2 shall be deleted and the following substituted:

"Members of Governing Body

1. The Governing Body of Charterhouse School shall consist of the Archbishop of Canterbury for the time
