TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Avon) (No. SW3) Order 1974" authorising the stopping up of a length of Cattybrook Street and an area of Jane Street, Redfield, Bristol, and requiring the provision of a new highway maintainable at the public expense for which the highway authority is to be the Avon County Council.
