BY THE QUEEN
A PROCLAMATION

FOR DISSOLVING THE PRESENT PARLIAMENT,
AND DECLARING THE CALLING OF ANOTHER

ELIZABETH R.

Whereas We have thought fit, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, to dissolve this present Parliament: We do, for that End, publish this Our Royal Proclamation, and do hereby dissolve the said Parliament accordingly: And the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Members of the House of Commons, are discharged from further Attendance thereat: And We being desirous and resolved, as soon as may be, to meet Our People, and to have their Advice in Parliament, do hereby make known to all Our loving Subjects Our Royal Will and Pleasure to call a new Parliament: And do hereby further declare, that, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, We have given Order that Our Chancellor of Great Britain and Our Secretary of State for Northern Ireland do respectively, upon Notice thereof, forthwith issue out Writs, in due Form and according to Law, for calling a new Parliament: And We do hereby also, by this Our Royal Proclamation under Our Great Seal of Our Realm, require Writs forthwith to be issued accordingly by Our said Chancellor and Secretary of State respectively, for causing the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons who are to serve in the said Parliament to be duly returned to, and give their Attendance in, Our said Parliament on Tuesday, the twenty-second

day of October next, which Writs are to be returnable in due course of Law.

Given at Our Court at Balmoral, this twentieth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and in the twenty-third year of Our Reign.

TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

1. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Cashier's Office at the Bank of England on Friday, the 27th September 1974, at 1 p.m. for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act, 1877, and the National Loans Act, 1968, to the amount of £120,000,000.

(being a multiple of one new half-penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.

5. Tenders must be made through a London Banker, Discount House or Broker.

6. Notification will be sent on the same day as Tenders are received, to the person whose Tenders are accepted in whole or in part. Payment in full of the amounts due in respect of such accepted Tenders must be made to the Bank of England by means of cash or by draft or cheque drawn on the Bank of England not later than 1.30 p.m. on the day on which the relative Bills are to be dated.

7. Members of the House of Commons are not precluded from tendering for these Bills.

8. Tenders must be made on the printed forms which may be obtained from the Chief Cashier's Office, Bank of England.

9. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury reserve the right of rejecting any Tenders.

*The City of Westminster (Bus Lanes) (No. 4)
Traffic Order 1974*

*The City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction)
(Amendment No. 29) Order 1974*

1. Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council on 20th September 1974 made the above-mentioned Orders under section 6 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport

Act 1968, so as to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the City of Westminster (Bus Lanes) (No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 1973.

2. The general effect of the City of Westminster (Bus Lanes) (No. 4) Traffic Order 1974 will be:

- (a) to create a bus lane on the south-east side of Piccadilly (to operate in a south-westerly direction) and to prohibit all vehicles from entering or proceeding in that bus lane;
- (b) to create a bus lane on the south-west side of Regent Street (to operate in a north-westerly direction) near its junction with Piccadilly and to prohibit all motor vehicles from entering or proceeding in that bus lane except licensed cabs and vehicles requiring access to or leaving any premises abutting the bus lane or accessible only therefrom;
- (c) to prohibit all vehicles from entering or proceeding in:

- (1) the carriageway which lies on the south-east side of the island site on which stands the Shaftesbury Memorial;
- (2) the carriageways which lie between the north-easternmost and south-easternmost island sites and between the north-easternmost and south-westernmost island sites situated opposite the junction of Piccadilly and St. James's Street.

The prohibitions referred to above will not apply to:

- (i) a stage or express carriage on a scheduled service;
 - (ii) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if it is reasonably necessary for that vehicle to enter a bus lane;
 - (iii) any vehicle being used in connection with the removal of any obstruction in a bus lane;
 - (iv) a vehicle being used for purposes in connection with the statutory powers or duties of a local authority or the supply of gas, water or electricity or in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to a bus lane, provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary for the vehicle to enter that bus lane;
 - (v) any vehicle if the driver thereof is obliged to enter a bus lane in order to avoid an accident and forthwith causes that vehicle to leave that bus lane;
 - (vi) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
 - (vii) any vehicle which enters the Piccadilly bus lane from any part of Piccadilly which does not comprise the bus lane at a point opposite the junction of Piccadilly and Duke Street if that vehicle forthwith enters Duke Street;
- (d) to revoke the provisions of The London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (Westminster) (No. 2) Regulations 1963 relating to Piccadilly and Regent Street and to re-enact those provisions in a form which takes account of the creation of the bus lanes and the carriageway referred to in sub-paragraph (c)(1) above;
- (e) to prohibit vehicles turning left from Piccadilly into Albemarle Street;
 - (f) to prohibit vehicles in Regent Street (south-east of Piccadilly) from turning right into Piccadilly Circus (south-east of the Shaftesbury Memorial).

3. The general effect of the City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 29) Order 1974 will be further to amend the City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1972, so that:

- (i) the existing prohibition on waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) which applies in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice will apply at any time of the day or night throughout the week;
- (ii) the existing prohibition on waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle which applies in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice will apply between 8.30 a.m. and midnight throughout the week;
- (iii) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle will be prohibited in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and midnight throughout the week.

4. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 3(iii) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform

or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; to licensed street traders, etc.

5. A copy of each of the Orders, which will come into operation on 1st October 1974, of the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (Westminster) (No. 2) Regulations 1963, of the City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1972 (and of the Orders which have previously amended that Order) and of the City of Westminster (Bus Lane) (No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 1973 can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made in Room B.21, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

6. Copies of the Orders may be purchased from the Information Centre, Greater London Council, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

7. Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to either of the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.—Dated 23rd September 1974.
