The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the public right of way running from the existing point of connection of the footpath with the street known as Austin Close, Charford, Bromsgrove (hereinafter referred to as "point 'A'") firstly in a southwesterly direction for a distance of 230 yards and thence generally in a southerly direction for a distance of 80 yards to point "B" to a line running from point "A" firstly in a westerly direction for a distance of 79 yards, thence generally in a southerly direction for a distance of 212 yards, thence generally in a westerly direction for a distance of 36 yards, thence generally in a southerly direction for a distance of 48 yards and finally in a westerly direction for a distance of 48 yards to the said point "B" to join the existing route of the footpath.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the Council Offices, Birmingham Road, Bromsgrove, and may be inspected free of charge between

the hours of 9 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. and 2.30 p.m. and 4.45 p.m. on any weekday (except Saturday).

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the District Council of Bromsgrove may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent to the Secretary of State with the Order.
