

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

Somerset (Eastern Moor Bridge over Cripps River, East Huntspill) (5 ton weight Restriction) Order, 1974

The Somerset County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles, the weight of which whether laden or unladen exceeds 5 tons from proceeding over Eastern Moor Bridge over Cripps River on the East Huntspill-Edington Burtle Road (Class III) in the Parish of East Huntspill.

The Order will provide that you will not be able to park your car (except to load and unload goods and to pick up and set down passengers) on the following lengths of road in Sale:

WILTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967

The County of Wiltshire (Various Roads, Trowbridge) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1974

Notice is hereby given that on the 4th October 1974, the Wiltshire County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be to prohibit and restrict waiting on the following roads in Trowbridge as follows:

(1) *Waiting prohibited at all times on lengths of the following roads:*

Adcroft Drive, Adcroft Street, Allen Road, Ashton Road, Ashton Street, Avenue Road, Back Street, Bradford Road,
