A PROCLAMATION

APPOINTING THURSDAY, 26TH DECEMBER 1974 A BANK HOLIDAY IN SCOTLAND AND NEW YEAR'S DAY 1975 A BANK HOLIDAY IN ENGLAND AND WALES AND NORTHERN IRELAND.

Whereas We consider it desirable that Thursday, the twenty-sixth day of December in the year 1974 should be a bank holiday in Scotland and that New Year's Day in the year 1975 should be a bank holiday in England and Wales and Northern Ireland:

We, therefore, in pursuance of section 1(3) of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971, do hereby appoint Thursday, the twenty-sixth day of December in the year 1974 to be a bank holiday in Scotland, and New Year's Day in the year 1975 to be a bank holiday in England and Wales and Northern Ireland, under the said Act.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace this sixteenth day of October, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-four, and in the twenty-third year of Our Reign.
