already found for railing 100 Millions of Livres, it is berlieved that they will not bring in 30. The Viceroy of Peru, a Native of Catalonia, having made his Application to the Cours of Paris and Madrid, was to be continued in the Government of that Kingdom three Years longer. These Letters add, that they were in great &xpectation of the Arrival of the Galleons with Bullion from the West-Indies.
